



## KGSA Spectator Contract

I agree to follow this spectator's conduct code and the instructions given by the coaches, umpires or board members. If I fail to follow the expectations or coaches' instructions, I will be disciplined or dismissed from the field.

### Parent/guardian/spectator expectations:

- a. Keep all comments positive.
- b. Encourage players from both teams.
- c. Stay off of the field and out of the dugout unless invited by a coach.
- d. No coaching. Leave the coaching to the coaches. If you have a suggestion please contact the head coach by telephone or email. Before and after games or practices are not good times to discuss matters. If you would like to meet in person please call the head coach and a meeting can be scheduled at an appropriate time.
- e. Do not criticize umpires, players, coaches, opponents or fans. If you feel compelled to voice your criticism please call the head coach and discuss it directly. Mistakes will be made; you should expect that. Remember this is girls' softball. The coaches are volunteers; many of the officials are just learning their skills and need as much grace as the girls. But without them there would be no game.
- f. Do not "beg" for or "suggest" calls to the officials. Do not tell the official how badly he/she blew the last play. It doesn't help us.
- g. Be supportive. **Do not stir up controversy.**
- h. Parents and guardians are responsible for all family members and friends attending the games. They will be held to the same standards as the parent/guardian.
- i. Report any issues or violations to the division player agent.
- j. Get involved in a positive way to make this a fun and positive experience for your kids.
