



KGSA Player Conduct Code and Contract

I agree to follow this player conduct code and the instructions given by my coaches. If I fail to follow the code or coaches' instructions, I will be disciplined or dismissed from the team.

1. I will address my coach as "Coach (first or last name)". I will respect my coaches at all times. I will never talk back to the coach. I will look my coach's eyes when he/she is speaking to me and will never turn my back on a coach when he/she is speaking.
2. I will respect and encourage my teammates on and off the field in a positive way.
3. I will show respect at all times to umpires and our opponents' players and coaches.
4. Sportsmanship is my number one priority in games and practice.
5. I will respect, protect, and maintain my equipment. I will NEVER throw my helmet, bat, or other equipment.
6. If I have a flagrant misconduct event, it will result in my immediate removal from the game and additional disciplinary action which may include suspension from the next game.
 - a. Flagrant Misconduct is any act that happens before, during, or after a game that an umpire, vice president, or board member considers serious enough to disqualify a player or coach from the game or tournament. For players, this includes but is not limited to biting, striking, butting, elbowing, and kicking an opponent. In addition, continual unsportsmanlike behavior can be viewed as flagrant misconduct.
7. I will always encourage my teammates in a positive way, no matter what happens.
8. I will attend all scheduled practices and games. If I am unable to do so, I will contact my coach in advance.
9. I will show up to games in full uniform and have all equipment ready to play my position(s) safely.
10. I will always conduct myself in a manner that represents the positive image of KGSA and myself while on and off the field.
